*The Governing Body of the City of Hill City met at City Hall on January 19, 2015, at 7:30 P.M. Mayor, Jean M. Bell presided with the following Councilpersons present: Kenneth L. Stewart, Les Burton, Steve George, and Mort Plunkett. Jeff Parsons was absent. Others present were: Karla Miller, Deb Budig, and Dennis Mersch. Jill Elliott was absent.*

*Steve George moved to approve the Minutes of the January 5, 2015 Council Meeting and the Accounts Payable. Mort Plunkett seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.*

*Mort Plunkett moved to approve the Treasurer's Quarterly Report as printed. Les Burton seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.*

*Steve George moved to approve the 2015 Electric and Plumbing License for Jacob's Plumbing. Les Burton seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.*

*Les Burton moved to approve Pay Request #15 to Midland's Contracting in the amount of \$80,643.60 for the Lagoon Project. Steve George seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.*

*Mort Plunkett moved to approve Resolution #15-01, "A RESOLUTION TO WAIVE THE ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF GENERALLY ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES AND FIXED ASSET ACCOUNTING." Les Burton seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.*

*Les Burton moved to approve Resolution #15-02, "A RESOLUTION FIXING A TIME AND PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF A HEARING BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILL CITY, KANSAS AT WHICH THE OWNERS HIS OR HER AGENTS, LIEN HOLDERS OF RECORD, OCCUPANTS AND OTHER PARTIES IN INTEREST OF STRUCTURES LOCATED WITHIN SAID CITY AND DESCRIBED HEREIN MAY APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY SUCH STRUCTURES SHOULD NOT BE CONDEMNED AND ORDERED REPAIRED OR DEMOLISHED AS UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS STRUCTURES." Kenny Stewart seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.*

Kenny Stewart moved to pay \$600.00 the first year for protective clothing for the Line Department and \$300.00 a year thereafter. Les Burton seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.

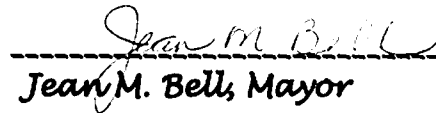
