

CITY OF HILL CITY
COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 16, 2015
7:30 P.M.

The Governing Body of the City of Hill City met at City Hall on March 16, 2015, at 7:30 P.M. Mayor, Jean M. Bell presided with the following Councilpersons present: Kenneth L. Stewart, Les Burton, Steve George, and Mort Plunkett. Jeff Parsons entered the meeting at 7:35 P.M. Others present were: Willard Riggs, Joey Ridpath, Colleen Hardiek, Russ Ingle, Deb Budig, Dennis Mersch, and Jill Elliott.

A Hearing was held at 7:30 P.M., for and at which the owner(s) his or her agent, any lien holders of record, any occupant and other parties in interest, as that term is defined by law, of the structures being addressed may appear and show cause why such structures should not be condemned as an unsafe or dangerous structure and ordered repaired and demolished. A start date of April 1, 2015 was given and the completion date was to be within 90 days which would be July 1, 2015. If deadline is not met at that time further proceedings will be taken. Hearing was then closed.

Mayor, Jean M. Bell then opened the Regular Council Meeting at 8:00 P.M.

Mort Plunkett moved to approve the Minutes of the March 2, 2015 Council Meeting and the Accounts Payable. Steve George seconded the motion which carried with a 4-0 vote.

Mort Plunkett moved to accept the proposal from Don's Electric and Rewind, Inc., to install generator and automatic transfer switch; add the flowmeter and chlorine leak detector signals to the telemetry control panel at the lagoons. Jeff Parsons seconded the motion which carried with a 5-0 vote.


Jeff Parsons moved to reappoint to the KMEA Board of Directors; Director #1 - Mort Plunkett, and Director #2 - Dennis Mersch. Les Burton seconded the motion which carried with a 5-0 vote.

Discussion was held concerning the following items: Delinquent utilities; Concensus for Chief Russ Ingle to purchase tablets for the Police Department; Concensus for Chris Smee to attend a D.A.R.E. School in South Dakota Mid June; Request for hearing on N. Pomeroy Properties; and dogs running at large.

Kenneth L. Stewart moved to adjourn meeting. Jeff Parsons seconded the motion which carried with a 5-0 vote. Meeting was then adjourned by Mayor, Jean M. Bell.
